The Glorious Reign of the Messiah
A Study of Isaiah #6

Isaiah 11:1-9

- The Messiah will reign in righteousness by the power of the Spirit of the LORD. (vv.1-5)
 - He will be a "Davidic" king. (v. 1)
 - He will reign by God's Spirit. (2-3)
 - He will reign in righteousness. (4-5)
- The Messiah's reign will bring peace to the whole of creation (v.6-9)
 - The Nature of the world will change. (vv.6-8)
 - There will be no more danger or destruction. (v.9)
